An association can be seen as an extension to your study program and has three main purposes: connection to the study program, gaining practical insight into the workfield, and having a great time during your student life! We offer you support with your study as well as a variety of activities that you can join.

As a VIP member, you also get discounts in many shops throughout the city, and you can buy study books with a large discount.

Furthermore, we offer the opportunity to work on your CV, for example by joining our activities or by becoming active in a committee. Besides that, we have a vacancy page for our members.

The most important aspect is that by joining VIP you get the chance to meet a lot of people and become part of our big VIP-family!

<u>Why did you join VIP?</u> When you join a society as big as VIP your social network increases rapidly. Because of the many activities they organise you make a lot of new friends. When you start a new study it can be exciting and a bit scary because you do not yet know a lot of people. So I joined VIP mainly in the hope of making some new friends. <u>How do you experience being a member of VIP?</u> I am not active in a committee or structure of VIP, but even though I'm not an active member, I'm viewed as such while joining the activities. In the Netherlands in general and in Groningen in particular, you will find a lot of associations: study associations, student associations, but also sports associations or cultural associations. People join associations for different reasons, but one of the main reasons to join any association is to meet new people and to have a great time during your student life.

Student associations only focus on the social aspect. However, some associations such as study associations or sports associations also offer something next to this. At VIP, the study association of psychology, you have the opportunity to get to know the study from a different perspective and to experience the field of psychology in a more practical way besides following your university courses.


This is not the only difference between student and study associations. Groningen has several large student associations, which are rather traditional compared to VIP and the largest ones also have a hazing period for prospective members. Furthermore, student associations are open for everybody to become a member. However, the activities of the associations are then rather exclusive to their members. In contrast, only students from a particular study can become a member of their study association, but the activities are usually open for everybody. Even though, VIP members still have priority for our activities and can get a discount of at least 30% for all of VIP's activities. 



Connection to the study program

One of the main goals of the association is to support your studies. Therefore, we offer professional exam trainings by one of our partners. These trainings are given by experienced tutors who have excellent knowledge of the course material. We aim to offer tainings for the subjects with which students have most difficulties, such as statistics. For the exact list of subjects you can check the website.

Secondly, we organize study days in the week before the exam week. When exams are coming up, the library is usually packed with students and it can be difficult to find a spot to study. Therefore, our study committee hires a room at the faculty for you in these weeks, so you can have a quiet place to study.

Last but not least, you can order your books with a large discount as a VIP-member. You can order all your books at once, which makes ordering books super easy for you!



Become active!

You can make your study time even better by becoming an active member of VIP! Currently, we have approximately 150 members who are active in one of our committees, structures or year representations. All of them contribute their bit to a successful year and make sure you have a good time at our activities. Becoming an active member does not only mean that you will contribute to the organization of activities, but you also become part of our active members group. In addition to the regular activities, you can also join active members' activities such as the barbecue in the Faculty garden or the active members' weekend. You can find an overview of the possibilities to become active on the next pages!

What does it mean to be part of a committee?

Within VIP, you can become active in committees, structures or within the year representation. Committees are mainly responsible for organizing activities, whereas structures are responsible to support the board and committees with certain tasks such as promotion or acquisition. Within the year representation, you represent the students and evaluate the quality of the courses.

Most committees have 6 members. Within the committee, there are different functions that will be fullfilled. The functions usually are the following:

- Chairman/woman
- Secretary
- Treasurer
- External contacts
- Acquisition
- Promotion

Every year in September a Committee market takes place where all committees, structures and year representations are present. Social Committees

- Social committee

This committee organises the most crazy parties and activities throughout the year! The parties take place at different locations and usually have a theme and people dress up.

- Dies committee

This committee organises the Diesweek/ Introduction camp. VIP celebrates its birthday and the arrival of new students with our Diesweek and introduction camp. Everybody is welcome, and there are a lot of fun activities or parties you can join. You definitely do not want to miss out on this!

- Event committee

This committee organises two big activities. One activity is usually a hitchhiking contest. The other one is the participation in the Batavierenrace.

- First year committee

Throughout the year, several activities will be organised for first year students to get to know each other. Examples are game nights, a yoga workshop or a cocktail workshop.

- Intercultural committee

Because we have two bachelor programs in Psychology, the group of psychology students is quite diverse. The intercultural committee organises activities where you can get insight into different cultures and meet students from different countries.

-Student exchange committee (SECcie) Every year an exchange takes place between psychology students from Groningen and another country. This exchange takes place in two separate weeks, one in Groningen and one in the hometown of the exchange partner.











-Yearbook committee
In addition to all of VIP's activities, the association is also handing out a yearbook in which,

among other things, all activities are described. The yearbook will be handed out in September.

-Zwemfest committee

Ths committee organises the annual Zwemfest festival for upcoming bands, which will take place in Vera.

Idea fund committees

VIP has an idea fund. If you have an idea for an activity that you would like to organise or a committee that does not exist yet, you can make a request at the idea fund. In case the request is successful, the idea fund committee is similar to a regular committee and continues to exist for the rest of the study year.

-Sport committee (Idea fund committee 2018-2019)

This committee organises a fun week of wintersports and a soccer tournament.

-Theater committee (Theun) (Idea fund committee 2017-2018)

This committee organises a fantastic theater play with actors from our own faculty.

Study related Committees

-Workshop/in-house committee This committee organises at least two psychology related workshops a year and organises daytrips to institutions or companies where psychologists work. Examples of workshops are mindfulness work-

shop, a sportpsycholgy workshop and criminal profiling. Every year, this committee also arranges a visit at the Mesdag clinic.











-Study committee

This committee takes care of all the study books that the students need for their upcoming year. They also arrange study days where students can come together and study for their exams.

-Lecture committee

Throughout the year, this committee organises different lectures with a psychology related topic. These lectures are held by an expert from his/her field. Examples of topics from last year are fetal alcohol syndrome and pedophilia.

-Career committee

This committee organises four career evenings each year. During these evenings, psychologists talk about their work fields, their experiences and the connection of study and work.

-BSS Congress Committee

This committee organises the biggest faculty wide event during a period of one year. This congress is focused on all the different studies within our faculty, so not only psychology.

-STOSO Congress Committee

This committee organises one annual conference on a theme related to Organisational & Social Psychology. On this day, people can follow workshops and lectures. Last year's conference was about dealing and managing crisis situations.











Structures

Structures are teams that support committees and the board with different tasks. On this page you an see which structures VIP has!

-Photo Structure

This structure is in charge of taking pictures of almost all activities organised by the committees or the board. A member of the structure attends the activity for free to take pictures.

-Bar & Cook Structure

This structure helps committees and the board with any dinner that needs to be cooked at activities, for example during the introduction camp, where they also help with maintenance of the bar. They also give advice to committees in terms of grocery quantity.

-Acquisition Structure (Tigers)

This structure helps committees reach their acquisition targets. The Tigers also help the board by contacting companies and making deals themselves.

-Promotion Structure

This structure helps committees and the board to make posters and flyers for any given activity.

-DJ Structure

The DJs make sure there's music on special events like the Introduction camp or the Active Members Weekend. They are also in charge of playing music during the monthly drinks at 'Het Pakhuis.'

-Audit structure

The members of this structure check the accountancy of VIP and the final account of the associations book year. (Only for former members of the VIP-board!)

Why did you decide to become active in a structure?

Before this, I was active in a committee, something I really enjoyed. In my second and third year at VIP, I still wanted to be an active member but with a little less obligations, so I decided to join a structure because there you have less regular meetings than in a committee. The year representation is the connection between students and teachers and represents the opinion of students. As a year representative, you will evaluate the quality of the courses and the study program as a whole. The year representation consists of a Dutch and and English year representation for each year. Each year representation consists of six students.
